

Model Risk Management Policy

Introduction

This policy sets out the principles for risk management within Highwood Copse Primary PTFA.

It is relevant to all within the association and is endorsed by the committee of Highwood Copse Primary PTFA.

It will be reviewed yearly to ensure that it remains appropriate to the Organisation and its volunteers needs annually.

Purpose

The purpose of Risk Management is to identify risks as early as possible, develop a strategy to mitigate those risks and implement a risk management process as part of our PTFA event planning process.

For all PTFA events:

A Risk Assessment is to be carried out by a committee member to:

Identify potential hazards

Identify who may be harmed by such hazards

Determine whether existing precautions are adequate or whether further action needs to be taken

Record your findings on the PTFA Risk Assessment template

Review your assessment and update when necessary

Take advice from the school/venue where appropriate – look at previous risk assessments and adhere to recommendations

Take advice from the HSE where appropriate – www.hse.gov.uk

A copy of the Risk Assessment to be kept in a designated folder for use by the PTFA Committee – this can be used for reference if the same event is being run in the future

A copy of the Risk Assessment given to the school if requested

All committee members should be made aware of each risk assessment.

This policy will be reviewed by the Highwood Copse Primary PTFA committee annually before the AGM.
